DATE: 3/25/20.

Due to the new requirements/guidelines given by Governor Tim Walz, SMART Transit will be making the following adjustments to services provided:

Effective Saturday, March 28, 2020, the following changes will be made:

- Saturday service will remain as is
- ALL Sunday services will be cancelled
- Deviated Route services will stop at 6:00pm, Monday Friday
- Demand Response services will be cut back, ensuring we have at least one
 in each city
- Shuttle service between Austin and Albert Lea will be cut to Monday,
 Wednesday, and Friday NO TUESDAY AND THURSDAY SERVICE
- Dispatch hours will be adjusted to have less people staffing phones,
 business hours will be maintained
- * We will continue to monitor demand and make adjustments as needed, as well as following any required/mandated changes ordered by government officials
- ** Meal delivery will continue as we are allowed and able
